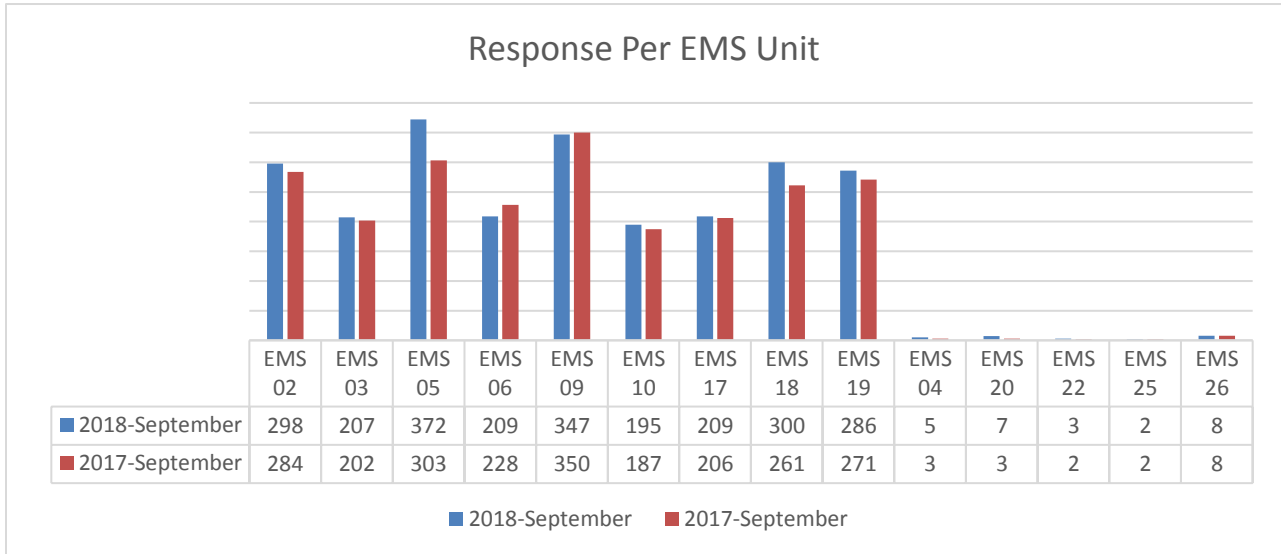
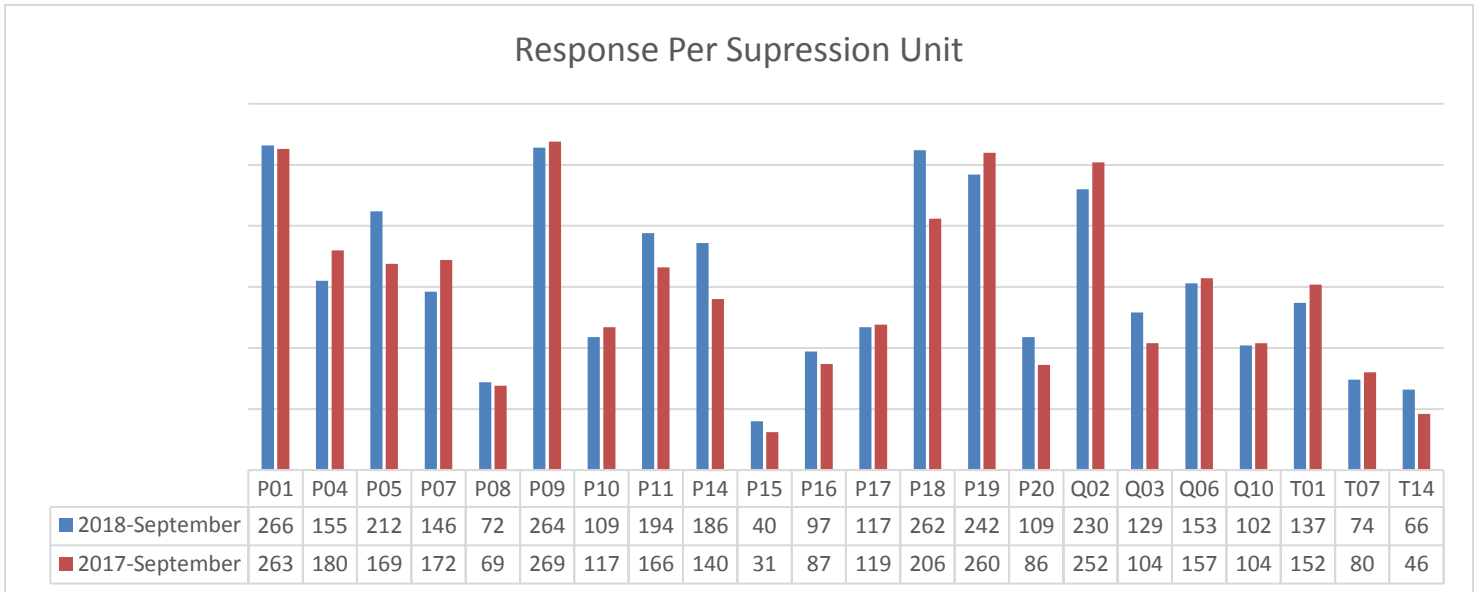




The Kansas City Kansas Department responded to 2827 incidents during the month of September 2018 based on CAD and NFIRS data.



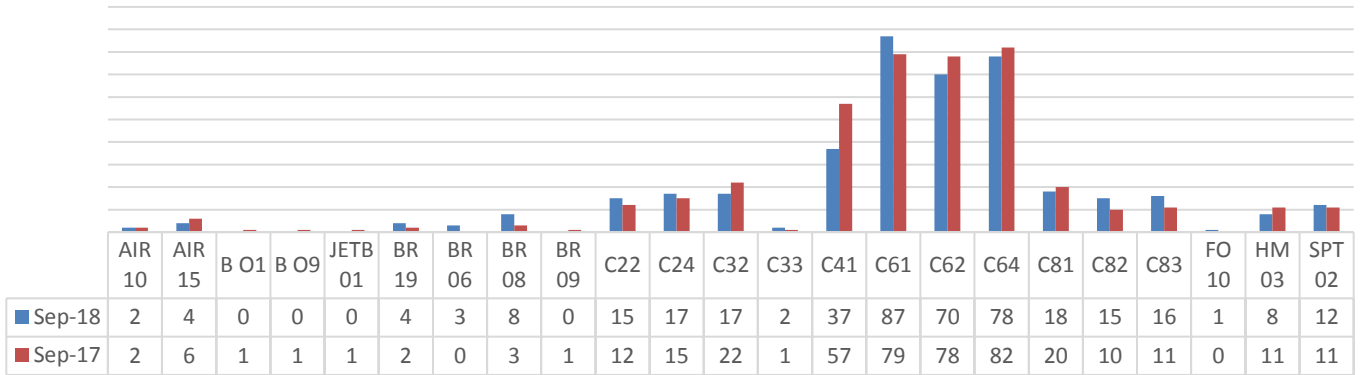
KCKFD EMS Units responded to an incident 2448 times in September 2018, 2564 times in August 2018 and 2310 times in September of 2017. This number is generated by CAD and NFIRS data. If more than one unit responded, each unit is counted as a response, however the incident is counted only once for our total response count.



KCKFD Suppression Units responded to an incident 3362 times in September 2018 and 3519 times in August 2018. In September of 2017 we responded to 3229 incidents. This number is generated by CAD and NFIRS data. If more than one unit responded, each unit is counted as a response,



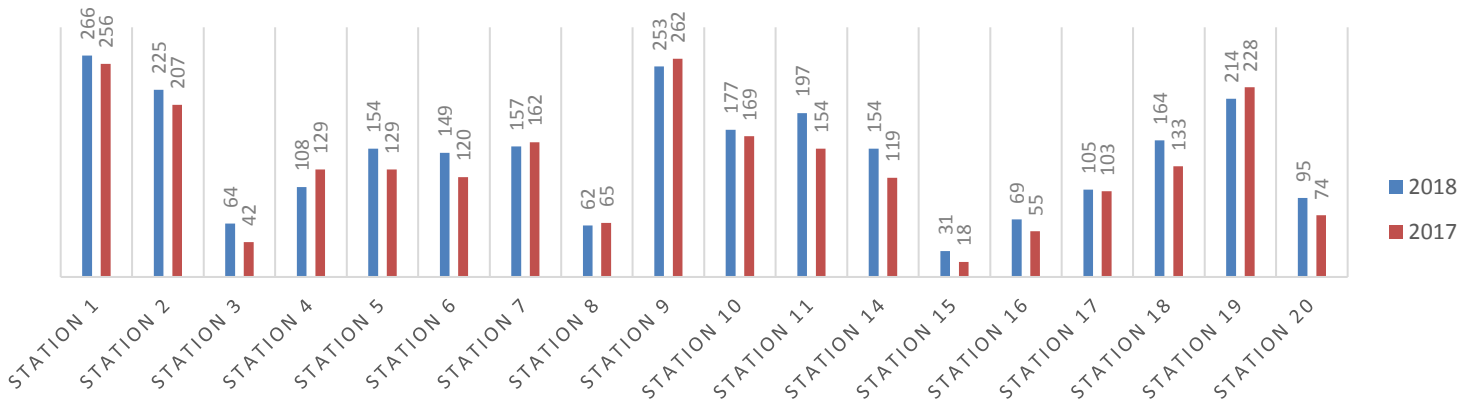
September 2018 / Response Per Specialty/Support Unit



however the incident is counted only once for our total response count.

KCKFD Support/Specialty Units responded to an incident 433 times in September 2018, 527 times in August 2018, and 457 times in September 2017. This number is generated by CAD and NFIRS data. If more than one unit responded, each unit is counted as a response, however the incident is counted only once for our total response count.

SEPTEMBER CALLS BY STATION TERRITORY



Calls by station territory are determined by first due territory response. Apparatus often respond to incidents in first due territory other than their own. For example: If Pumper 20 responds to an incident in Pumper 19's first due territory, the activity will be reflected in Pumper 20's Response per Suppression Unit but in Station 19's Response by Station Territory. Note: The non-emergency transfers from PMC and KUMC, which elevated the data for Station 10 and Station 19, has been removed from the above table. 199 non-emergency transfers counted only in the EMS Unit that completed the transfer. There are 17 calls not reflected on this graph. We responded on Mutual Aid, 10 times to Bonner Springs and once to Edwardsville. There are 8 uncategorized incidents.



NFIRS

For the month of September, we had 2,826 calls for service. We had an initial report completion percentage of 88.1%. Currently, there are 148 reports that still need to be completed which is a 94.8% completion percentage after 1 notification. Of those 148 reports, 54 are from 1st shift, 30 from 2nd, and 64 from 3rd.

I completed reports for June and July and submitted them to the state. There are still 24 reports needed from August. Each month's reports "should" be submitted to the state by the 20th of the next month.

The Goal of the KCKFD is 100% completion for all NFIRS reporting.
