The Kansas City Kansas Fire Department provides FIRE/EMS services for an estimated 146,000 population. The **Firefighter Trainee Program** provides the opportunity for Wyandotte County residents ages 18-30 to pursue a career in the fire service. Selected Firefighter Trainees will enter an accelerated Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training program with the Kansas City Kansas Community College. Firefighter Trainee must pass class with a minimum 2.0 GPA, and meet criteria for State testing. Firefighter Trainee will be required to test for Kansas State EMT certification as prescribed by the KCKFD and KCKCC, and **will have the opportunity to transition to Paramedic with financial assistance.** EMT'S with the National Registry Certification (EMT-P) must complete the conversion process with the Kansas Board of Emergency Medical Services for Kansas Certification.
